Curry Chicken Recipe

One whole chicken - cooked/shredded or equivalent amount of any chicken parts

4 Cups Chicken broth

2 Onions sliced or chopped

2-3 tomatoes chopped

1 red pepper chopped

16 oz plain yogurt

15 oz Can coconut milk

Garlic salt to taste

Olive oil to brown onions

Curry to taste



Cooking Instructions:

Sauté sliced onions until transparent. Mix in chopped tomatoes and peppers and cook for a few minutes. Add garlic salt and curry to taste. In a separate bowl, mix plain yogurt and 2 cups of chicken broth until well blended. Then add to the onions along with coconut milk and rest of chicken broth and stir until well blended. Add Shredded chicken and more curry and garlic salt to taste. Simmer for about 20-25 minutes on low heat.

Cook 2 or 3 cups of Jasmine rice with chicken broth. Serve Curry Chicken over the Rice and ENJOY! (6-8 Servings)
