PRESS RELEASE - January 9, 2013:

ARRESTS BY PATROL

1. **WAYWARD JUVENILE - Disorderly Conduct:** On January 2nd, 2013 at 9:53 PM, Sergeant Michael Lawing and Patrolman Steven Gravier arrested a **15-year-old juvenile male** at the Corkery House for Boys, 15 Baker Pines Road, Richmond, on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after officers were dispatched to that address to handle the youth who had engaged in a violent and profane outburst, during which time he threw an item at another juvenile resident. Officers returned the youth to the station where he was processed, and subsequently released to his father. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
2. **Bench Warrant:** On January 3rd, 2013 at approximately 1:03 AM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **James W. Vickers**, age 50, of 330A Church Street, Richmond on the strength of an outstanding **4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on December 27, 2012, for *Failure to Appear / Ability to Pay* on an original charge of *Operating on a Suspended License* (Hopkinton Police Department). The arrest was the result of a motor vehicle stop on Main Street in Wyoming. Mr. Vickers was processed at the station and was arraigned before a Justice-of-the-Peace, and was released after posting the requisite bail of \$684.50.
3. **Misdemeanor - Simple Assault:** On January 3rd, 2013 at approximately 11:00 AM, Patrolman Justin Vachon arrested **Susan G. Sawtelle**, age 53, of 200 Shannock Village Road, Apartment B, Shannock on a charge of **Simple Assault and/or Battery**, after the officer was dispatched to investigate a complaint at the above address. Mrs. Sawtelle was transported to the station where she was processed and subsequently released with a summons to appear for arraignment on January 24th, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above criminal charges.
4. **Misdemeanor - Reckless Driving:** On January 4th, 2013 at approximately 3:15 AM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Adam M. Cafferty**, age 21, of 61 Sherman Avenue, Apartment 3, Richmond on a charge of **Reckless Driving**, after the officer stopped Mr. Cafferty for speeding at **75-MPH** in a posted **30-MPH-zone** on Kingstown Road near Meadowbrook Road. (It should be noted that approximately 25 minutes earlier at 2:46 AM, Corporal Litterio had stopped Mr. Cafferty for speeding along Route 138 at 29-MPH over the posted 40-MPH-speed limit.) Mr. Cafferty was processed at the station and released with a summons to appear for arraignment on January 31st, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above charge.

5. **WAYWARD Juvenile – Disorderly Conduct:** On January 4th, 2013 at 12:30 PM, Patrolman Jeff Vaughn arrested a **16-year-old female student** at Chariho High School on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after school deans reported that she had engaged in a disruptive and profane outburst, forcefully kicking lockers in the hallway and screaming obscenities. She was returned to the station where she was processed and subsequently transported home. She shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.

6. **Misdemeanor – Motor Vehicle:** On January 5th, 2013 at 2:25 AM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **Dominic H. Walmsley**, age 42, of 180 High Street, South Kingstown on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License** after a motor vehicle stop on Kingstown Road near Stilson Road revealed that his license to drive had been suspended in May 2012. Mr. Walmsley was processed at the station and subsequently released with a summons to appear for arraignment on January 31st, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above criminal charge.

7. **Misdemeanor – Motor Vehicle & Bench Warrant:** On January 5th, 2013 at approximately 3:00 AM, Patrolmen Daniel Kelley and Andy Briody arrested **Jason H. Coon**, age 37, of 335 Church Street, Richmond on a charge of (1) **Operating on a Suspended License** and (2) **on the strength of an outstanding 4th District Court Bench Warrant**, after officers were dispatched to the Richmond Mobil for a well-being check. Mr. Coon’s license had been suspended in December 2009 for *Failure to Perform Community Service*, and the bench warrant had been issued on December 5th, 2012, for *Failure to Appear / Pay Fines* on a prior conviction in 2012 for *Operating on a Suspended License* (Westerly Police Department). Mr. Coon was processed at the station and was issued a summons to appear for arraignment on January 31st, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above criminal charges. He was unable to post the requisite surety bail due on the warrant, and had to be transported to the Intake Service Center at the ACI.

8. **WAYWARD JUVENILE – Disorderly Conduct:** On January 6th, 2013 at 7:30 PM, Patrolman John Randall arrested a **17-year-old juvenile male** at the Corkery House for Boys, 15 Baker Pines Road, Richmond, on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after being dispatched to that address for an unruly juvenile who had admitted smoking marijuana and subsequently engaged in disorderly behavior, banging on walls and threatening staff members at the program. The youth was returned to the station where he was processed, and then by order of an after-hours Family Court Judge, he was held on emergency detention at the Rhode Island Training School in Cranston, pending a hearing in Family Court the next morning.

9. **WAYWARD JUVENILE – Simple Assault & Disorderly Conduct:** On January 6th, 2013 at 8:20 PM, Sergeant Michael Lawing and Patrolman John Randall arrested a **14-year-old juvenile male** at the Corkery House for Boys, 15 Baker Pines Road, Richmond, on charges of (1) **Simple Assault and Battery**, and (2) **Disorderly Conduct** after staff members witnessed him repeatedly punch another youth in the head. The youth was returned to the station where he was processed, and subsequently released to his mother. The youth shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
