PRESS RELEASE - January 15th, 2013:

ARRESTS BY PATROL

- Misdemeanor - Shoplifting, Obstruction, Vandalism, and Disorderly:** On January 9th, 2013 at approximately 8:25 PM, Sergeant Michael Lawing responded to the Cumberland Farms on Main Street, Wyoming, and arrested **Patrick J. Lepore**, age 32, of 159 Robinson Street, Wakefield after a store employee reported that Mr. Lepore had shoplifted food items and then walked off of the premises. Sergeant Lawing located Mr. Lepore walking along Main Street away from the Cumberland Farms and arrested him. At the time of his arrest, Mr. Lepore offered a bogus name and date of birth. When Sergeant Lawing attempted to fingerprint Mr. Lepore, he became combative and uncooperative, at which time he was secured in a detention cell. While in the detention cell, Mr. Lepore broke a set of handcuffs, and repeatedly kicked and punched the cell walls and door. He was subsequently charged with (1) **Shoplifting**, (2) **Obstruction of a Police Officer**, (3) **Disorderly Conduct**, and (4) **Vandalism**, and was later released with a summons to appear for arraignment on January 24th, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above criminal charges.
- Misdemeanor -Violation No-Contact Order:** On January 10th, 2013, at approximately 12:00 PM, Lieutenant John Arnold arrested **David Ziegenfuss**, age 28, of 165 Kenyon Hill Trail, Richmond on a charge of **Violation of a No-Contact Order**, after he accompanied an officer from the RI Department of Probation on a visit to 165 Kenyon Hill Trail and found Mr. Ziegenfuss inside with a woman he was barred from contact with based on an active court issued *No-Contact Order*. Mr. Ziegenfuss was transported to the station where she was processed before being transported to 4th District Court for arraignment on the above criminal charge.
- Affidavit & Arrest Warrant from Hopkinton PD:** On January 11th, 2013 at approximately 9:30 AM, Lieutenant John Arnold assisted Captain Mark Carrier of the Hopkinton Police Department with a motor vehicle stop on Carolina Nooseneck Road, which led to the arrest of **Jonathan A. Maggs**, age 20, of 7 Wolf Court, Richmond on the strength of an outstanding **Affidavit and Arrest Warrant** held by their agency on a charge of *1st Degree Child Molestation* (Hopkinton Police Department). Mr. Maggs was released to Captain Carrier's custody at the scene.

4. **Bench Warrant:** On January 14th, 2013 at approximately 1:00 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Jason Roberts**, age 33, of 47 Potter Avenue, West Warwick on the strength of an outstanding **4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on October 26th, 2012, for *Failure to Appear* on an original charge of *Domestic Simple Assault* (Westerly Police Department). The arrest was the result Corporal Litterio seeing Mr. Roberts, who he recognized as being wanted, approaching the front door of 46 Kingstown Road. Mr. Roberts was processed at the station and was delivered to 4th District Court on the strength of the bench warrant.
5. **WAYWARD Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On January 14th, 2013 at 1:30 PM, School Resource Officer Anthony Zoglio arrested a **15-year-old female student** at Chariho High School on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after she struck another female student in the face during a confrontation that occurred in a hallway during change of classes. Staff members interrupted the altercation immediately after it was observed. She was subsequently turned over to her stepmother, and shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
6. **Misdemeanor - Simple Assault:** On January 14th, 2013 at approximately 2:40 PM, Patrolman Jeffrey Vaughn arrested **David F. Laucks**, age 27, of 7 Chariho Drive, Wyoming on a charge of **Simple Assault and/or Battery**, after an investigation into a citizen complaint that Mr. Laucks had assaulted a male passenger in his vehicle while it was parked on Spring Green Drive, Wyoming, in the early morning hours of Sunday, January 13th, 2013. Mr. Laucks was processed at the station and was released with a summons to appear for arraignment on February 7th, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above criminal charge.
7. **Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle:** On January 15th, 2013 at 2:30 AM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **Kiel L. Teklinsky**, age 30, of 9 Pine Shadows Drive, Hope Valley on a charge of **Operating on a Suspended License** after a motor vehicle stop on Nooseneck Hill Road revealed that his license to drive had been suspended in November 2012. Mr. Teklinsky was processed at the station and was subsequently released with a summons to appear for arraignment on February 7th, 2013, in 4th District Court on the above criminal charge.
