## PRESS RELEASE – September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2013:

1. **Bench Warrant:** On August 27, 2013, at 1:30 AM, Patrolman John Randall arrested **Ryan S. Williams**, age 30, of 36 Shickasheen Way, South Kingstown on the strength of an outstanding **4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on May 10, 2013, for *Failure to Appear/Costs Review – (South Kingstown PD)*, during a motor vehicle stop on Kingstown Road. Mr. Williams was processed at the station. He was unable to post the requisite surety bail of \$1307.10 (equivalent of \$130.70 in cash bail), so he was transported to the Intake Service Center at the ACI.
2. **Misdemeanor – Reckless Driving & Eluding Police:** On August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013, at approximately 1:50 AM, Patrolman John Randall arrested **Brian Eich**, age 38, of 222 Sylvan Street, South Kingstown, on charges of (1) **Reckless Driving** and (2) **Eluding Police – High Speed Pursuit**, after accelerating his 1995 Honda to over 80-MPH on sections of Route 138 Eastbound (Kingstown Road). Mr. Eich's vehicle peaked at **105-MPH in a posted 45-MPH zone**, just before he pulled over and surrendered to Officer Randall near the Beaver River Golf Course on Kingstown Road. Mr. Eich was processed at the station, and was later released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on the above charges.
3. **WAYWARD JUVENILE – “Hit & Run Accident”:** On August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013, at approximately 9:52 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested a **17-year-old female resident** of Charlestown, on charges of **Leaving the Scene of an Accident – Damage to Attended Vehicle**, after he recognized the description of a suspect vehicle that fled from a “hit & run” crash on Kingstown Road at Carolina Nooseneck Road, as the same vehicle that he had stopped moments earlier. Corporal Litterio contacted the Charlestown Police Department to assist in visiting the address of the suspect operator. She was subsequently processed at the Richmond police station and was released to her mother. She shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.

4. **Bench Warrant:** On August 29, 2013, at 11:49 AM, Patrolman Jeff Vaughn arrested **Jacob Guilbert**, age 21, of 28 Yankee Drive, Westerly on the strength of an outstanding **4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on May 29, 2013, for *Failure to Appear – Operating Suspended License (Narragansett PD)*, during a motor vehicle stop on Church Street. Mr. Guilbert was processed at the station, and was subsequently transported to 4<sup>th</sup> District Court.
5. **Misdemeanor – Disorderly Conduct:** On August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013, at approximately 7:10 PM, Patrolman Jeff Vaughn and Corporal William Litterio, assisted by the Sergeant Tom Quaratella of the Hopkinton Police Department, arrested **Ronald B. Erler**, age 41, of 220 Skunk Hill Road, Hope Valley, on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct**, after an investigation into a complaint that Mr. Erler and an associate had followed the complainant’s vehicle from Main Street in Wyoming to a residence on Woodville Road, where Mr. Erler and his associate allegedly pulled into the driveway and verbally threatened and taunted the complainant’s friend. Mr. Erler was processed at the station, and was later released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2013, for arraignment on the above charge.
6. **Misdemeanor – Disorderly Conduct:** On August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013, at approximately 7:10 PM, Corporal William Litterio and Patrolman Jeff Vaughn, assisted by the Sergeant Tom Quaratella of the Hopkinton Police Department, arrested **Curt E. Palmer**, age 45, of 76 Canonchet Road, Hope Valley, on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct**, after an investigation into a complaint that Mr. Palmer and an associate had followed the complainant’s vehicle from Main Street in Wyoming to a residence on Woodville Road, where Mr. Palmer and his associate allegedly pulled into the driveway and verbally threatened and taunted the complainant’s friend. Mr. Palmer was processed at the station, and was later released with a summons to appear in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2013, for arraignment on the above charge.
