## PRESS RELEASE - April 16, 2013:

- 1. WAYWARD Juveniles - Disorderly Conduct:** On April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2013, at approximately 2:45 PM, School Resource Officer Anthony Zoglio was informed of a fight in progress at the Chariho High School senior parking lot. He subsequently learned that two male students had engaged in a physical altercation that began from a dispute over a parking spot. Officer Zoglio subsequently arrested **both 17-year-old male students** on a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*. Both juveniles shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
- 2. WAYWARD Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On April 11, 2013, at approximately 11:30 AM, School Resource Officer Anthony Zoglio arrested a **17-year-old male student** of Chariho High School on a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*, after he engaged in a series of profane verbal outbursts directed at the school staff. The youth was released to the custody of his grandmother, and shall be petitioned into Family Court on the above charge.
- 3. FELONY - Domestic Felony Assault, Simple Assault & Disorderly Conduct:** On April 10, 2013, at approximately 6:00 PM, Patrolman John Randall of the Richmond Police Department initiated an investigation into a domestic assault complaint that had been filed by a female Richmond resident, who reported that an assault had occurred about 24-hours earlier at her Richmond home, and resulted in an injury. The Richmond Police obtained a court-authorized affidavit and arrest warrant for the alleged perpetrator, **Gary LaBelle**, age 41, of 46 Arcadia Road, Hopkinton, on charges of (1) *Domestic - Felony Assault*, (2) *Domestic - Simple Assault/Battery*, and (3) *Domestic - Disorderly Conduct*. The Hopkinton Police Department subsequently arrested Mr. LaBelle on the strength of the aforementioned warrant, and turned him over to the custody of Patrolman Jeffrey Vaughn of the Richmond Police Department. After being processed, Mr. LaBelle was arraigned before a Justice-of-the-Peace on the above charges, and was released on \$10,000 personal recognizance with a *No-Contact Order* barring him from any contact with the victim.

4. **Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle:** On April 12, 2013 at approximately 5:30 PM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **James A. Prucha**, age 33, of 110 Post Road, Apt. 122, Westerly, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Switch Road revealed that his license had been suspended for *No Proof of Insurance/Financial Responsibility*. Mr. Prucha was transported to the station where he was processed, and subsequently released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4<sup>th</sup> District Court on the above charge.
