PRESS RELEASE – July 16th, 2013:

1. **Misdemeanor - DUI (BAC > .15):** On July 6, 2013, at approximately 5:45 PM, Patrolman Anthony Zoglio, assisted by Corporal William Litterio, arrested **Eric M. Pease**, age 40, of 107 Woodville Road, Richmond, on a charge of *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st Offense - BAC greater than .15)*, after a motor vehicle stop on West Shannock Road. Officer Zoglio stopped the vehicle after monitoring a radio broadcast by the South Kingstown Police Department about a suspected drunk/erratic driver operating a 1994 Honda with a child passenger. Mr. Pease was arrested on suspicion of DUI after performing a series of Standard Field Sobriety Tests. Corporal Litterio subsequently located an open can of beer, half-full and cold to the touch, under the driver's front seat. Officers notified DCYF about the aforementioned circumstances and the fact that Mr. Pease's 8-year-old child was a passenger in the vehicle. The child was transported and released to the youth's mother. Mr. Pease submitted to a Breathalyzer test that resulted in BAC (blood-alcohol-content) readings of **.245 (1st phase)**, and **.261 (2nd phase)**. Mr. Pease was processed and later released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
2. **FELONY - Possession of a Controlled Substance:** On July 8, 2013, at approximately 8:32 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Scott Evanchof**, age 29, of 34 Delta Drive, Pawtucket on a charges of (1) *Possession of a Controlled Substance (Heroin)* and (2) *Operating without a License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Kingstown Road for an alleged speeding violation of traveling 68-MPH in a posted 40-MPH-zone. Mr. Evanchof was processed at the station, and was arraigned by a Justice-of-the-Peace. Mr. Evanchof, who was unable to post the requisite \$5,000 surety bail (\$500), was transported to the Intake Service Center at the ACI.

3. **Misdemeanor - DUI (BAC Unknown):** On July 9, 2013, at approximately 12:30 PM, Patrolman Adam Andrukiewicz, assisted by Detective Drew Bishop, arrested **Jayne C. Goode**, age 45 of 24 Hillcrest Road, Milton, MA, on charges of (1) *Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and/ or Drugs (1st Offense - BAC unknown)*, and (2) *Refusal to Submit to a Chemical Test*, after the Department received several calls from citizens reporting an erratic driver on Woodville Road, crossing into Richmond from Hopkinton. Patrolman Andrukiewicz located Ms. Goode's vehicle stopped on Sandy Pond Road, missing a front tire which had apparently dislodged from the rim at least 150 yards earlier. Evidence supported that Ms. Goode drove for 1.8 miles with a flat passenger's side front tire. Officers also found an open container of an alcoholic beverage in the vehicle. Ms. Goode was transported to the station where she was processed, and later released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court and RI Traffic Tribunal on the above charges (respectively).

4. **Misdemeanor -Arrest Bench Warrant:** On July 12, 2013, at approximately 4:30 PM, Corporal William Litterio responded to 21 Lewiston Avenue, Richmond, and arrested **Joslynn L. Park**, age 36, of that address, on the strength of an outstanding *4th District Court Bench Warrant*, which had been issued on July 10, 2013 for *Failure to Appear for Child Support (Reciprocal Body Attachment)*. Ms. Park was processed at the station and was subsequently transported to the Women's Intake Center at the ACI.

5. **Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle:** On July 12th, 2013 at approximately 9:20 PM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **Koty T. Miller**, age 23, of 1741 Ten Rod Road, Exeter, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop in Richmond revealed that his RI operator's license had been suspended in January 2013. Mr. Miller was transported to the station, where he was processed and released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
