PRESS RELEASE – July 31st, 2013:

ARRESTS BY PATROL

1. **Misdemeanor – Motor Vehicle:** On July 18th, 2013 at approximately 10:00 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Joshua E. Pucino**, age 34, of 4 North Switch Road, Richmond, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Main Street in Richmond revealed that his RI operator's license had been suspended in March 2013 for *Failure to Appear/Pay*. Mr. Pucino was transported to the station, where he was processed and released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
2. **FELONY – Larceny over \$500 (Copper Theft):** On July 24, 2013, at approximately 12:47 AM, Sergeant Michael Lawing, assisted by Patrolman Andy Briody, arrested **Mark Campagnone**, age 31, of 21 Mawney Avenue, Warwick on a charges of (1) *Larceny over \$500 (theft of copper from unoccupied dwelling)*, (2) *Possession of Burglary Tools*, and (3) *Operating on a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Route 95 Northbound (from Kingstown Road). Sergeant Lawing observed the vehicle make a suspicious and abrupt turn off of Kingstown Road into a Church parking lot, and travel towards the highway. Sergeant Lawing learned that the operator, Campagnone, had a suspended driver's license. Sergeant Lawing also observed several lengths of copper pipe, dripping water, along with bolt-cutters inside of the van. Subsequent investigation by Detective Drew Bishop and Sergeant Lawing revealed that the copper had been cut and stolen from an empty house-for-sale on the eastern end of Kingstown Road in Richmond. Mr. Campagnone was processed at the station, and was released later that morning with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charges.

3. **Misdemeanor - Arrest Bench Warrant:** On July 24, 2013, at approximately 4:30 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Kathleen E. Raymond**, age 25, of 6F Maple Lake Farm Road, Hopkinton, on the strength of an outstanding *Affidavit and Arrest Warrant by the Charlestown Police Department*, on charges of *Domestic Simple Assault and Domestic Vandalism*. Ms. Raymond was processed at the station and was subsequently turned over to the Charlestown Police Department.
4. **Misdemeanor - Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** On July 25th, 2013 at approximately 6:22 PM, Corporal William Litterio arrested **Michael McDermott**, age 31, of 3786 South County Trail, Richmond, on a charge of *Domestic Disorderly Conduct*, after he was dispatched to that address for a report of a disorderly male subject. Upon arrival, Corporal Litterio learned Mr. McDermott had engaged in tumultuous conduct, including discarding/throwing belongings into a driveway during a disagreement with a family member. Mr. McDermott was processed at the station. He was arraigned by a Justice-of-the-Peace on the above charge, and was released on personal recognizance along with a No-Contact Order barring him from any contact with the victim.
5. **Misdemeanor - Motor Vehicle:** On July 28th, 2013 at approximately 2:00 AM, Patrolman Daniel Kelley arrested **Emanuel Jackson, III**, age 49, of 79 Cass Street, Providence, on a charge of *Operating with a Suspended License*, after a motor vehicle stop on Pleasant Street in Richmond revealed that his RI operator's license had been suspended on July 26th, 2013, for *Failure to Appear/Pay*. Mr. Jackson was transported to the station, where he was processed and released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on the above charge.
