PRESS RELEASE – June 11th, 2013:

1. **FELONY – 1st & 2nd Degree Child Molestation:** On June 6th, 2013 at approximately 2:14 PM, Detective Drew Bishop, assisted by Lieutenant John Arnold and Patrolman Andy Briody, responded to 23 Canob Drive, Wyoming and arrested **Kevin M. Williams**, age 31, of 66 Shannock Hill Road, Richmond on the strength of a Richmond Police Department affidavit and arrest warrant charging him with (1) *1st Degree Child Molestation*, and (2) *2nd Degree Child Molestation*. The arrest stemmed from an investigation by Detective Bishop into a complaint that was made on May 28th, 2013, by a juvenile female who reported that Mr. Williams had engaged in sexual contact and sexual penetration with her on multiple occasions when she was between the ages of seven (7) and ten (10) years old. Mr. Williams was processed at the station, and was subsequently arraigned in 4th District Court where he was ordered held without bail (HWOB), pending a bail status conference on June 12th, 2013.
2. **Misdemeanor – Simple Assault and Disorderly Conduct:** On June 7th, 2013 at approximately 1:00 PM, Sergeant Michael Lawing responded to the Chariho High School and arrested a student, **Christopher T. Ancona**, age 18, of 30 Evans Lane, Hopkinton on charges of (1) **Simple Assault and/or Battery** and (2) **Disorderly Conduct**, after Mr. Ancona spat in the face of a school dean, and repeatedly threatened to physically assault the dean in the presence of others. Mr. Ancona was transported to the station where he was processed. Mr. Ancona was released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on June 27th, 2013, on the above charge.
