PRESS RELEASE – May 21, 2013:

1. **Bench Warrant:** On May 16, 2013 at approximately 9:00 AM, Patrolman Steven Gravier arrested **Stacey R. Vonseeberg**, age 36, of 619 Beach Pond Road, Voluntown, CT on the strength an outstanding **3rd District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on July 23, 2011, for *Failure to Appear* on an original charge of *Misdemeanor Shoplifting* (Coventry Police Department), after she was involved in a minor traffic collision at Cumberland Farms on Main Street. Mrs. Vonseeberg was processed at the station before being transported to District Court.
2. **FELONY – Fraudulent Use of Credit Card:** On May 16, 2013, at approximately 6:00 PM, Detective Drew Bishop arrested **Jackeline Sainz Azurduy**, age 35, of 193 Scapa Flow Road, Charlestown on a felony charge of (1) *Fraudulent Use of Credit Card*, and a misdemeanor charge of (2) *Larceny Under \$500*, after an investigation by Detective Riley of the Westerly Police Department into a complaint involving a resident of Westerly being defrauded by Ms. Sainz Azurduy at the Stop & Shop in Wyoming on April 25th, 2013. Ms. Sainz Azurduy surrendered herself at the station, where she was processed before being released with a summons to appear in 4th District Court for arraignment on the above charges on May 30th, 2013.
3. **Misdemeanor – Disorderly Conduct:** On May 16, 2013 at approximately 10:30 PM, Patrolmen Steven Gravier and John Randall arrested **David Kennedy**, age 42, of 5 Myrtle Avenue, Richmond on a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*, after officers were dispatched to an address on Church Street in Alton where an intoxicated male subject was reportedly threatening to “beat up” the boyfriend of his ex-wife. Mr. Kennedy was arrested and transported to the station where he was processed, and was released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on June 6th, 2013, on the above charge.

4. **WAYWARD Juvenile - Disorderly Conduct:** On May 17, 2013 at 11:24 AM, School Resource Officer Anthony Zoglio arrested a **16-year-old male student** at the RYSE Program at Chariho High School on a charge of **Disorderly Conduct** after he disrupted the learning environment with a profane outburst directed at staff members. The youth was processed at the station and was turned over to his father. He shall be referred to Family Court on the above charge.
5. **Misdemeanor - Disorderly Conduct:** On May 17, 2013, at approximately 1:37 PM, School Resource Officer Anthony Zoglio and Corporal William Litterio arrested **Stone Hebert**, age 46, of 18 Teaberry Lane, Hopkinton on a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*, at the Chariho High School after Mr. Hebert reportedly engaged in a physical confrontation with his son, who was facing school discipline. There were no known injuries. Mr. Stone was processed at the station before being released with a summons to appear was released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on June 6th, 2013, on the above charge.
6. **Misdemeanor - Disorderly Conduct:** On May 17, 2013, at approximately 6:10 PM, Patrolman Steven Gravier arrested **Matthew P. Jeffries**, age 47, of 49 Bucknam Road, Richmond on a charge of *Disorderly Conduct*, after investigating a complaint that Mr. Jeffries had driven his motorcycle towards a 14-year-old youth on Riverview Drive, and threatened him with physical violence relative to a perceived injustice towards a family member of Mr. Jeffries. The juvenile complainant also reported that Mr. Jeffries gestured in a threatening manner with and while holding his motorcycle helmet. Mr. Jeffries surrendered himself at the station where he was processed before being released with a summons to appear for arraignment in 4th District Court on June 6th, 2013, on the above charge.
7. **Bench Warrant and Motor Vehicle:** On May 18th, 2013 at approximately 5:00 PM, Sergeant Michael Lawing arrested **David Gregoire**, age 34, of 180 Shannock Hill Road, Apt. 283, Richmond on the strength an outstanding **4th District Court Bench Warrant** that had been issued on May 10, 2013, for *Failure to Appear for Sentencing* on an original charge of *Operating on a Suspended License* (Richmond Police Department), and a new charge of *Operating on a Suspended License*. Arrest stemmed from a motor vehicle stop on Richmond Townhouse Road. Mr. Gregoire was processed at the station and was subsequently arraigned before a Justice-of-the-Peace on the suspended license charge, and was released on \$1,000 personal recognizance after posting the requisite surety bail of \$4,770, or \$477, which is the 10% equivalent in cash.)

8. **Misdemeanor - Simple Assault & Disorderly Conduct:** On May 21, 2013, at approximately 11:00 AM, Lieutenant John Arnold arraigned **Dennis M. Kenyon**, age 24, of 38 Sagamore Drive, Charlestown on charges of (1) *Simple Assault* and (2) *Disorderly Conduct*, in 4th District Court on the strength of a Richmond Police Department affidavit and arrest warrant. The arrest was the result of an investigation by **Patrolman Dan Kelley**. While on 3rd shift patrol on April 26th, at 11:30 PM, Patrolman Kelley checked a suspicious vehicle that pulled behind a business on Main Street and parked, at which time he found the 18-year-old operator bleeding with apparent head injuries. Patrolman Kelley called for the Hope Valley Ambulance. The youth, who suffered a broken nose and contusions, reported that he had been assaulted by at least two male subjects at an address on Canob Lane. Mr. Kenyon was arraigned before the 4th District Court on the above charge, and was held without bail as a Superior Court violator.
