

Kingston Bridge Replacement Richmond



What's happening?

As part of its project to replace the Kingston Road Bridge in Richmond, the Rhode Island Department of Transportation will close Route 138 at the bridge for five consecutive nights starting on Monday night, September 7. Detours will be established directing motorists to use I-95 north or south, get off at the next highway exit, and get back on the highway and take Exit 3 on the other side of the bridge. A detour map will be posted at www.ridot.net/detourmaps.

When is it happening?

For the week of September 7, the detour will be in place from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
